- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 0.8% in Ventura County, CA from 383,217 to 386,269. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.4% by 3.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 62.9% to 62.1% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **22.1% of Ventura County, CA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (0.5% above the national average), and **9.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Crop Production.









## **Unemployment by Ethnicity**





### **Population Trends**



### **Job Trends**






Ventura County, CA had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 5.23%, decreasing from 8.74% 5 years before.




#### Millennials

Ventura County, CA has 164,144 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 171,020.




#### **Veterans**

Retirement risk is about average in Ventura County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 252,614 people 55 or older, while there are 263,224 here.




#### **Violent Crime**









### **Top Growing Industries**






### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**









#### Unique Average Monthly Postings






